#### Kansas Geological Society (KGS) Medallion for Scientific Distinction and Excellence

The Kansas Geological Society (KGS) Medallion for Scientific Distinction and Excellence may be given annually for peer-recognized, sustained significant scientific contributions to all facets of applied Kansas geology, including work either in Kansas or in surrounding states if the latter contributions pertain directly and significantly to Kansas geology. No more than one award may be given each year, an award does not have to be given every year, and members of the KGS Awards Committee that handle nominations for this award cannot nominate themselves for this award. The candidates need not be active KGS members, and they must be living at the time of selection. The primary consideration in the selection of a candidate shall be his or her sustained, published, significant contributions to any facet of Kansas geology. Contributions may be varied in form such as development of geologic concepts, advancement in discovery thinking, and recognized leadership in exploration concepts. Oral and/or written publications in peer-reviewed geological venues is a requisite criterion for any candidate for this award. The name of a candidate shall be presented by the Awards Committee to the KGS Board of Directors for their approval. Once approved, the recipient shall be presented an appropriate award in the form of a medallion or plaque recommended by the Awards Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at the annual business meeting of the society. This is a new award given by the KGS for distinction and achievement in Geological research in Kansas.

Awards Committee members are Sal Mazzullo, Mike Dealy and Alfred James.

President's Letter

Greetings everyone!

In our last issue I said it has been a difficult time for our industry, especially as the world economy stumbles with the Corona virus. I had no idea. I said it may affect how we do business on a daily basis. I had no idea.

### KGS and Industry Members Lost in 2020

#### Lee E. Phillips, III

Lee E. Phillips, III — The Phillips family is saddened to announce the passing of husband, father and grandfather Lee Eldas Phillips, III, of Wichita Kansas, who left this world Easter morning, April 12, 2020, at the age of 88. Survived by his beloved wife, Marlene of Wichita; sons, Scott (Anne Yard) of Webster Groves, MO, and Jamey (Anne Paar) of Portland, OR; granddaughter, Claire of Webster Groves, MO; and brother, Innes Phillips, Sr. (Karen) of Wichita and cherished nieces and nephews. Lee was a graduate of Wichita East High School. While attending the University of Kansas he was drafted into the U.S. Army and served in the Korean War. After the cessation of hostilities Lee returned to and graduated from KU and joined his father's oil production firm. In 1960 he married Marlene Mohr, a marriage that lasted 59 years. A collector of American Art, accomplished golfer, and avid fly fisherman. Lee had a large love of life and a firm appreciation for what was truly important: living a good life with family. Lee enjoyed a successful career in the oil and gas industry. He was President of the Lee Phillips Oil Company and the CEO of Anchor Minerals, Inc., both in Wichita, Kansas. He was an enthusiastic supporter of the University of Kansas, Beta Theta Pi Fraternity, the National Organizations of the Boy Scouts and the Girl Scouts of America, the Wichita Art Museum, and Woolaroc Museum, Bartlesville, Oklahoma. He also served on the Board and as the President of the Board of Trustees of Woolaroc. He strove throughout his career to maintain the high standards of business that personified his father Lee Phillips, Jr. and the determination and grit that exemplified his grandfather, L. E. Phillips, Sr., a co-founder of Phillips Petroleum Company. Lee also had a keen sense for business instilled by his grandfather Walter Pease Innes, Sr., owner of Innes Department Store. Lee took true pride in his Korean War service and was an American patriot through and through. Loved in life, passed in peace, Lee Eldas Phillips III, lived a long and blessed life. # Exploration Highlights

1. Arcadian Resources LLC, Concordia (KS), has discovered oil deposits in the Mississippian formation at the #1-27 Green High well, spotted in the SW/4 of section 27- T27s- R12W, in Pratt County. The new unnamed pool discovery was made over one mile north of the Lunt Southeast oil field (Established. 3/23/2019 - LKC oil), about 4 miles northwest of the town of Cairo, KS. The well was drilled by Fossil Drilling tools to a total depth of 4502 ft by logger's measurements. Promising DST shows were also recovered in the LKC and Marmaton formations but remain untested behind pipe. No completion details have been released. (ref: API 15-151-22504)

2. Independent producer Charles N. Griffin, Pratt (KS), has discovered oil in the Viola formation at the #1Paislee - a pool step-out and new pay discovery well in Pratt County. The well was drilled to a total depth of 4900 ft at location in the SW/4 of section 21- T29s- R15W. Viola oil adds to resources in the Springvale Townsite pool, where Mississippian oil has been produced since 2007 and Simpson oil since 2009. The field has produced nearly 46,000 barrels of oil from four wells since its discovery by Lotus Operating Company, LLC, Wichita (KS). The Paislee lease lies nearly 9 miles southwest of Cullison, KS. Completion details remain confidential. (ref: API 15-151-22505)

3. MURFIN DRILLING COMPANY, Wichita (KS), has established a new unnamed oil field in Cheyenne County with the completion of the #1-6 Burr well. The new discovery was made about four miles north and one mile east of the town of Bird City in section 6- T3s- R37W. Operator bottomed the well at a rotary total depth of 5100 ft. Commercially productive zones were found in the Lansing - Kansas City formation. No completion details have been released. Closest known production can be found nearly one mile to the southeast of the Burr lease in the now abandoned Buffalo Plains field in the NE/4 of section 8. The one-

well pool produced a total of 11,238 bbl of oil from June 2010 until plugged in August 2017. The Shawnee, LKC and Marmaton zones were once productive. (ref: API 15-023-21530)

4. Independent oil producer L. D. DRILLING INC, Great Bend (KS), has successfully drilled and completed the #1-32 Anderson at a total depth of 4230 ft in Decatur County. The wildcat well has discovered isolated oil deposits in the SE SW NE of section 32- T4s- R29W. It lies about one-half mile northwest of the #1 Prosch, NE SE SE in section 32 - the pool discovery well for the Lund field (Established. 1982). Dry holes separate the two wells. Both wells are producing oil from the Lansing - Kansas City limestones. The Anderson well will be considered as an infield discovery in the field. Production rate has not been disclosed. Field area is located 10 miles south and 3 miles west of Oberlin, KS. (ref: API 15-039-21268)
