

Kansas Geological Society (KGS) Medallion for Scientific Distinction and Excellence

The Kansas Geological Society (KGS) Medallion for Scientific Distinction and Excellence may be given annually for peer-recognized, sustained significant scientific contributions to all facets of applied Kansas geology, including work either in Kansas or in surrounding states if the latter contributions pertain directly and significantly to Kansas geology. No more than one award may be given each year, an award does not have to be given every year, and members of the KGS Awards Committee that handle nominations for this award cannot nominate themselves for this award. The candidates need not be active KGS members, and they must be living at the time of selection. The primary consideration in the selection of a candidate shall be his or her sustained, published, significant contributions to any facet of Kansas geology. Contributions may be varied in form such as development of geologic concepts, advancement in discovery thinking, and recognized leadership in exploration concepts. Oral and/or written publications in peer-reviewed geological venues is a requisite criterion for any candidate for this award. The name of a candidate shall be presented by the Awards Committee to the KGS Board of Directors for their approval. Once approved, the recipient shall be presented an appropriate award in the form of a medallion or plaque recommended by the Awards Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at the annual business meeting of the society. This is a new award given by the KGS for distinction and achievement in Geological research in Kansas.

Awards Committee members are Sal Mazzullo, Mike Dealy and Alfred James.






Honorary Member Profile of Salvatore "Sal" Mazzullo

Sal was born in Brooklyn, New York in 1948 He was the oldest of three boys and one girl. Sal, Louis, James, and Georgia were born to Joseph and Mary Mazzullo.

Sal went to Brooklyn College and graduated with a BS in Geology in 1969 and a MS degree in 1971. He enrolled at Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute where he studied under Dr. Gerald Friedman. He graduated with a PhD in 1974.

In 1975, he was hired at Texaco Research Laboratory in Houston, as the Senior Research Geologist. There he learned the "Texaco Way". What he learned was he did not enjoy Houston, the "Way" or Texaco.

Later that same year he took a position as an Assistant Pro-



fessor of Geology at the University of Texas Permian Basin, in Odessa, Texas. He taught at Odessa for three years. While there he ran field trips for Chevron teaching their employees carbonate deposition. Phillips Petroleum had him work on the Central Basin Platform. These field trips got him noticed by a number of geologists and companies. One of those was a VP for Union Texas Petroleum who hired him in 1978 for nearly six times what he was making at the university. He worked on stratigraphic trap prospects in Pennsylvanian and Permian rocks in the Permian Basin. In 1979, he studied carbonate depositional environments in the Gulf of Mexico and the Caribbean, which included the coastal waters of Belize.


From 1981 to 1987, he worked in Midland, as a petroleum consulting geologist for many domestic and international oil companies.


In 1987, a position opened at Wichita State University teaching courses in carbonate sedimentology and petroleum geology. He was working with Dr. James Gundersen, Dr. John Gries, Dr. Collette Burke and Dr. Bill Bischoff. He worked at WSU until 2012 when he retired. Since leaving WSU he has been working as a petroleum consulting geologist for a number of both large and small companies trying to determine the Mississippian stratigraphic architecture, depositional environments, and outcrop to subsurface correlations.

Since retiring, Sal and Chellie have been traveling extensively to many locations in the U.S. as well as in Europe and Belize. Sal has two children from a previous marriage: Joseph Mazzullo, a nurse practitioner in Bakersfield, California, and Lainie Hart of Wichita, working at Strategic Communications at WSU; and he has 4 grandchildren, all girls. Sal's hobbies include fishing, gardening, traveling, wine and micro-brew tastings; and most recently, playing and singing early rock and roll music with Dave Clothier as half of The Elderly Brothers. If you are in the KGS Library and see Ted Jochems or any of the integrators, give any of them a great big thanks for their efforts in continuing the tedious process of examining, scanning and integrating new logs and geologist's reports etc. into our library and the WDL.

As of January 1, 2020, the Foundation has **two full time employees** working on well log integration: Helen Cruz and Shuyao Li (a.k.a. Emily) along with Ted Jochems. They work forty hours per week, with Ted Jochems putting in 20-30 hours. More than a dozen other part-time integrators have worked on the project since 2010.

Grant Request Recipients

Integration Update as of September 30, 2019

From 01 January to 30 September of 2019, 21,900 well logs were examined by the integrators. 5,889 were new logs for the Walters Digital Library. 1,818 logs were re-scanned to replace poor existing digital images.

Over the nine year history of the integration project, 216,487 well logs have been examined. 62,934 (29.1%) were new to the WDL, with 6,288 logs re-scanned to replace poor existing images.





Exploration Highlights

1. L.D. Drilling, Inc., Great Bend (KS), has a new Mississippian (Osage) oil discovery in Ness County. The #1-13 Sampson Trust is producing an undisclosed amount of crude oil at site located in approximately NE SW NE in section 13- T18s- R23W. The wildcat found the new reserves almost two miles southwest of the Langer oil field (1974) where production began from the Osage formation until Cherokee oil was later discovered in the field in2005. The Langer pool has produced nearly 218,000 bbls of oil to date. L.D. Drilling's latest oil field has not been named. (ref: 15-135-26077)

2. Jolen Operating Company, Oklahoma City (OK), has established the new Majestic oil field in Clark County with the successful completion of the #1-3 Philip Glen Trust, spotted in approximately SE NE SE in section 3- T33s- R24W. The new wildcat discovery well was drilled to a total depth of7050 ft at site located seven miles west of Ashland, KS. Crude oil is being recovered from the Lansing - Kansas City formations. Details remain confidential currently. Other closest known production lies nearly three miles to the northwest in the Red Cliff oil field (1987), which produced around 7,700 bbls of oil from the Viola formation over a fiveyear period before being abandoned. (ref: API 15-025-21608)

3. Stelbar Oil Corporation, Wichita (KS), is producing oil from the Marmaton formation at the #1-2 Eaton in Scott County. The wildcat discovery well opens the new Range Rider oil field

about three miles south and four miles east of Scott City, KS. Sterling Drilling tools bottomed the well at a total depth of 4723 ft in the Mississippian formation. Drill site was chosen in approximately NE SE SW in section 2- T19s- R32W. Completion details are being held as confidential. The new reserves were discovered nearly two miles southwest of the Newby South oil field (1990), which also produced a small amount of oil from the Marmaton. (ref: API 15-171-21255)

4. Geosouthern Operating II LLC, of The Woodlands (TX), has discovered new oil reserves in the Lansing-Kansas City (K and L zones), upper Marmaton, and Pawnee formations at the #1-28 Cress new pool opener in Sherman County, northwest Kansas. The wildcat well was drilled to a rotary total depth of 5,000 ft at site located in approximately SW NW SE in section 28-T7s-R37W, about four miles north and thirteen miles east of Goodland, KS. Discovery well lies nearly two miles northwest of established production in the Gertrude West oil field (Marmaton and Cherokee - Johnson Zone oil), which was recently discovered by Chizum Oil LLC in section 35-T7s- 37W. Geosothern's new oil field has not been named. (ref: API 15-181 -20628)

5. Merit Energy Company LLC, Dallas (TX), has stepped nearly three-quarter mile northwest of existing oil production in the Cowgill Field (2015, Marmaton and Morrow Sand oil) to recover crude from the upper Morrow Sand at their #8 McWilliams (E) in Finney County. The infield discovery well was drilled to a total depth of 5146 ft at site located in approximately SE SW NW in section 21- T24s- R33W. No production details are available. The town of Holcomb lies about three miles northeast of the new discovery. (ref: API 15-055-22523)

6. Black Oak Exploration, Denver (CO), has discovered new oil reserves from the Marmaton (Fort Scott limestone) at the #1-29 Ryan, spotted in approximately SE NW NE in section 29-T5s- R31W, in Rawlins County. The new unnamed pool opener found the oil deposits one and one-half miles southeast of producing wells in the MJR East oil field, where the Marmaton (Pawnee limestone) and Shawnee (LeCompton limestone) formations have given up oil since 2012. No production information is available on Black Oak's new find. The 1-29 Ryan was drilled to a total depth of 4579 ft about seven and one-half miles south of the town of Achilles. The new oil field has not been named.
